SPEAKERS IN OUR WORSHIP SPACE

The tall, skinny white speakers mounted on the wall on either side of the chancel area are vocal/audio speakers.

The black-covered speakers mounted inside the center window on either side of the Christ statue are organ speakers.

The large boxes resting on the floor on either side of the platform are organ sub-woofers.

HOW IS OUR EARLY CHILDHOOD PROGRAM SHAPING UP?

Mrs. Duin reports that so far there are 33 enrolled for preschool and 16 for daycare. Five of those 16 are infants.

The majority of employee positions are filled. We still need to fill positions with infant care. Teenagers are encouraged to apply.

PIANO TUNING & ORGAN “VOICING”

After the piano was moved to this location, it is being allowed to rest till the end of the month. Then it will be tuned. This allows the instrument to settle with the climate, humidity level, etc. of the facility before it is tuned.

In a similar way, an organ specialist will be coming later this month to calibrate and “voice” the organ -which means to digitally tune it, adjust the speakers and align it to the worship space.
