THE UNIQUENESS OF THE LUTHERAN LITURGICAL SERVICE

Since Lutherans take seriously the Bible’s teaching about original sin and justification, the purpose of the liturgical service is not merely to facilitate YOU reaching up to God to GET salvation. (The Bible’s teaching of original sin says that you could never do that.) Nor is the purpose to incite you to feel something. (The Bible’s teaching of original sin says, “Surely the human mind and heart are cunning” -Psalm 64:6. Feelings are deceptive.) Rather, the primary purpose of Lutheran worship, safeguarded with the help of the liturgy, is simply to announce the Bible’s teaching of justification: because of Jesus’ sufferings and death on the cross, God has declared you “not-guilty” or forgiven of all sins! In words and songs it makes this declaration over and over again. The service helps to keep us centered on Christ and on God’s clear announcement. Your salvation is not the result of what takes place in your mind, but in the mind of God.

Stay between services for the Bible study “Idols We Never Knew We Had.” This series will continue each Sunday until Christmas.
