THEME: PENTECOST 14 - CHRIST SHEPHERDS THE STRAYING THROUGH THE CHURCH

No, He does not sit back in heaven and wait for us to come to Him. Nor should we take the attitude that it is enough that our church doors are open - let them come if they want. Rather Christ emerges from heaven and actively seeks out the lost. How? He works through the congregation of believers to reach those who do not know Him and also to call back those who have strayed and fallen into sin.

Christ says the Sacrament is an expression of unity (1 Co 10:16-17). We WANT to be unified with you on the basis of Christ and His doctrine! SERVICE OF WORD & SACRAMENT¹

OPENING HYMN Gracious Savior, Grant Your Blessing | CW 764:1,2, 4,5

(Why are we opening the service with a hymn about marriage today? Two of the three Scripture Lessons pertain to marriage. In the first lesson God directs the prophet Hosea to marry an adulterous woman. In the second lesson the Apostle Paul directs the congregation in Corinth to restore a believer who repented of marital infidelity.)

INVOCATION

M: The grace of our Lord \oplus Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you.²

C: And also with you.

CONFESSION OF SINS

God invites us to come into his presence and worship him with humble and penitent hearts. Therefore, let us acknowledge our sinfulness and ask him to forgive us.

Holy and merciful Father, I confess that I am by nature sinful and that I have disobeyed you in my thoughts, words, and actions. I have done what is evil and failed to do what is good. For this I deserve your punishment both now and in eternity. But I am truly sorry for my sins, and trusting in my Savior Jesus Christ, I pray: Lord, have mercy on me a sinner.

God, our heavenly Father, has been merciful to us and has given his only Son to be the atoning sacrifice for our sins. Therefore, as a called servant of Christ and by his authority, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son \oplus and of the Holy Spirit.

Amen.

¹ The liturgical service is a dialog between God and His people through the minister. The people confess their sins... God responds with an announcement of forgiveness. The people respond by praising God and praying for spiritual gifts. God responds by speaking to them through the Scripture lessons – and on it goes.

² The rest of the service will be the fulfillment of this greeting.

For the well-being of your holy Church in all the world and for those who offer here their worship and praise hear our prayer, O Lord.





FIRST READING Hosea 3:1-5

¹The LORD said to me, "Go again. Show love to a woman who is loved by another man, a woman who keeps committing adultery. Show love just as the LORD loves the people of Israel, even though they keep turning to other gods and loving the raisin cakes."

²So I bought her for myself for fifteen pieces of silver and nine bushels of barley. ³I said to her, "You will stay with me for many days. You must not be promiscuous. You must not be with any other man, and I will also be for you."

⁴So the people of Israel will live many days without king or prince, without sacrifice or sacred memorial stones, and without the special vest or family idols. ⁵Afterward the people of Israel will return and seek the LORD their God and David their king. They will come trembling to the LORD and to his goodness in the latter days.

⁵Now if anyone has caused sorrow, he has not done it to me, but to all of you to some extent (not to overstate it). ⁶This punishment inflicted on such a person by the majority is enough, ⁷so that instead you should rather forgive and comfort him, or else such a person could be overwhelmed by excessive sorrow. ⁸For that reason, I urge you to reaffirm your love for him. ⁹In fact, this was also the purpose of my writing: I wanted to know the result of your being tested, that is, if you are obedient in all things.



GOSPEL⁵ Luke 15:1-10

¹All the tax collectors and sinners were coming to Jesus to hear him. ²But the Pharisees and the experts in the law were complaining, "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them."

³He told them this parable: ⁴"Which one of you, if you had one hundred sheep and lost one of them, would not leave the ninety-nine in the wilderness and go after the one that was lost until he finds it? ⁵And when he finds it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders ⁶and goes home. Then he calls together his friends and his neighbors, telling them, 'Rejoice with me, because I have found my lost sheep!' ⁷I tell you, in the same way there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous people who do not need to repent.

⁸"Or what woman who has ten silver coins, if she loses one coin, would not light a lamp, sweep the house, and search carefully until she finds it? ⁹And when she finds it, she calls together her friends and neighbors and says, 'Rejoice with me, because I have found the lost coin.' ¹⁰In the same way, I tell you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents."

⁵ Why are we standing for this reading? We stand for something important – like when you stand as the judge enters the courtroom or as the American flag passes by in a parade. Jesus is presenting Himself to us in the Gospel Lesson. We stand in recognition of this.

NICENE CREED




